

## Congressional Office Building Navigation Guide

### House Side:

- Rayburn → Longworth
  - Take elevator/stairs to Sub Basement (SB) level (Hint: look for the SB button on elevator grid)
  - Follow signage on walls to Longworth
- Longworth → Cannon
  - Take elevator/stairs to Basement level (Hint: look for the B button on elevator grid)
  - Follow signage on walls to Cannon Tunnel
- Cannon → Longworth/Rayburn
  - Take elevator/stairs to Basement level (Hint: look for the B button on elevator grid)
  - Follow signage on walls to Cannon Tunnel and Longworth Basement
  - If heading to Rayburn from Cannon, follow signage to escalators after entering Longworth; take escalators down to Rayburn Sub-Basement

### Senate Side:

- When walking to/from any of the Senate Office Buildings:
  - Take elevator/stairs to the Basement level (Hint: look for the B button on elevator grid)
  - Follow signage on walls in tunnels to destination

## Understanding the Room Numbers

- All room numbers will be either 3 or 4 digits.
- Rooms with 3 digits:
  - The first digit in the number indicates the floor level of the room. Take the elevator or stairs to the appropriate level and follow the signs to the appropriate room. All rooms are in numerical order.
    - Ex: 231 Cannon is located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.
    - Ex: 104 Hart is located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor.
- Rooms with 4 digits:
  - The first digit indicates the building. Rayburn and Longworth are the only building with 4-digit room numbers.
    - 1 will be the first number for all Longworth rooms. Ex: 1365 Longworth.
    - 2 will be the first number for all Rayburn rooms. Example: 2145 Rayburn.
  - The second digit in these room numbers indicates the appropriate floor level. Take the elevator or stairs to the appropriate level and follow the signs to the appropriate room. All rooms are in numerical order.
    - Ex: 1365 Longworth is located on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor
    - Example: 2145 Rayburn is located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor
